Here's what she said:

What am I doing wrong?

Okay, I'm tired of beating around the bush, I'm a beautiful (spectacularly beautiful) 25-year old girl. I'm articulate and classy. I'm not from New York. I'm looking to get married to a guy who makes at least [a] half a million a year. I

know how that sounds, but keep in mind that a million a year is middle class in New York City, so I don't think I'm overreaching at all.

Are there any guys who make 500K or more on this board? Any wives? Could you send me some tips? I dated a businessman who makes average around 200 - 250K. But that's where I seem to hit a roadblock. 250,000K won't get me to Central Park West. I know a woman in my yoga class who was married to an investment banker and lives in Tribeca, and she's not as pretty as I am, nor is she a great genius. So what is she doing right? How do I get to her level?

Here are my questions specifically:

- Where do you single rich men hang out? Give me specifics - bars, restaurants, gyms.
- What are you looking for in a mate? Be honest guys, you won't hurt my feelings.
- Is there an age range I should be targeting (I'm 25)?
- Why are some of the women living lavish lifestyles on the Upper East Side so plain? I've seen really "plain Jane" boring types who have nothing to offer married to incredibly wealthy guys. I've seen drop dead gorgeous girls in singles bars in the East Village. What's the story there?

- Jobs I should look out for? Everyone knows - lawyer, investment banker, doctor. How much do those guys really make? And where do they hang out? Where do the hedge fund guys hang out?
- How you decide marriage vs. just a girlfriend? I am looking for MARRIAGE ONLY.

Please hold your insults - I'm putting myself out there in an honest way. Most beautiful women are superficial; at least I'm being up front about it. I wouldn't be searching for these kinds of guys if I wasn't able to match them - in looks, culture, sophistication, and keeping a nice home and hearth.

The response she got was as follows:

I read your posting with great interest and have thought meaningfully about your dilemma. I offer the following analysis of your predicament. Firstly, I'm not wasting your time, I qualify as a guy who fits your bill; that is I make more than \$500K per year. That said, here's how I see it:

Your offer, from the perspective of a guy like me, is plain and simple a crappy business deal. Here's why. Cutting through all the B.S., what you suggest is a simple trade: you bring your looks to the party, and I bring my money. Fine, simple. But here's the rub - your looks will fade and my money will likely continue into perpetuity ... in fact, it is very likely that my income increases but it as an absolute certainty that you won't be getting any more beautiful!

Physical Reflection

How do you feel when you take a look in the mirror? Not in terms of your face but in terms of your overall body. Do you feel good about the way you look, do you feel healthy, are you really satisfied with your overall health? Chances are that you aren't happy with the way your body is, and for good reason.

You don't want to be out of shape, you want to be in shape right? Maybe you want toned arms or a nice flat tummy, whatever it is, I want you to know right now that you can get it. But you have to want these things because they make YOU feel good about yourself.

So always keep physical reflection in mind when it comes to the type of guy you want to attract.

Emotional Reflection

Decision Time

You’re going to eventually have to get comfortable with yourself in your more natural state. So you might as well ease up on the make up now and try the more natural look. You’ll be surprised at how much more guys love it. Remember, sometimes less is more!

Chapter 4: Decision Time

When it comes down to landing dates with great guys and getting into relationships, guys are expecting you to have the final say. It's time to decide which guy you want to date.

Very Important Lesson to Know Before You Date

Landing dates is fairly easy with guys. You could probably go up to 10 guys, give them your number and 8 of them would call or text you back wanting to date or hit the sheets. Fast forward to the end of the movie, one of those dramatic church scenes goes down where he fly's through the doors and stops the wedding just as the "I do's" were about to happen. In the end the girl tells her almost husband/Irish prince charming "you're the perfect man, but not the perfect man for me."

My point is this: No matter how smart, funny, good looking, wealthy, family oriented or any other quality the guy is or has, every guy that's good to you isn't necessarily good for you.

Let me say that one more time: **every guy that's good to you isn't necessarily good for you.**

Intentions

Gentlemen do exist, but behind every gentlemen is a sexual beast. Understand that one of the main intentions of guys is to get into your pants, it's the honest truth and it's something you need to accept. Agreed, you shouldn't be viewed as a sex object all the time, but if you weren't viewed as a sex object then the human species wouldn't exist. So be thankful that men are the way they are. And be thankful that men are looking at you as a sex object, they could look at you in a completely different and far worse way. The Funny Guy offers a sense of well...fun! He loves to include you in hanging out with his friends, wants to be around you a lot and will do anything to make you smile. He will also go out of his way to please you, but unlike the nice guy, he'll expect something in return. You'll love the short term perks of being able to laugh all the time, but as far as the long haul goes, the funny guy that is willing to commit to a relationship may be hard to find since he's probably always spending his time with his friends. channeled towards you and never to another girl. If you feel like you have the qualities to bring to the table then this is definitely a guy to consider.

Chapter 5: Value Based Qualities

So if you don’t have a job, then go out and do what you can to land one. Do it to better your own circumstances, but also because you’re hard working and know you’re capable of so much more.

Educated

This can go both ways, because sometimes guys are actually intimidated by an educated woman. But this is usually not the case, guys love a woman that is smart. I mean, you like a guy that’s well educated and intelligent right? Guys are attracted to the exact same quality.

One of the most common conversations that you’ve probably had before is all about education. “Where did you go to school” and “what year did you graduate?” It usually starts with high school merits but then gradually goes up to college talk as you grow up a bit. In a sense, your education isn’t only to land you a good job and a nice little career, it’s also a resume that men look at.

So if you aren’t educated at a 4 year university, then do what you can to get into one or attend a trade school where you can get certified in a specific craft. Or

maybe educate yourself thoroughly on your passion and know everything about that, that is also a form of education. As long as your education is ongoing and is applied to your life for the greater good, guys will consider you to be intelligent and smart.

Be Ambitious

Always, always, always be ambitious at whatever you're doing, have a bigger picture, vision, or goal attached to the end of it. Don't just go to work for a paycheck or for the sole purpose to pay rent. Although those things are important right now, they aren't that important in the long run.

Guys want to know that you're actually going somewhere in life, that there's more to you than just the normal routine. Attracting men is a very crowded space, and it's the little things like this that are really going to separate you from the rest of the pack.

If you don't have a bigger picture attached to what you're doing right now, don't worry, you aren't going to be alone and never get a guy. Develop your own life and reach your own goals first, then share your life with the right guy. Don't go and depend on the ambition of another guy to fulfill your life, if you do you'll be left as an emotionally dependent wreck. Guys call this being needy. Have your own ambitions, goals and long term visions first.

The list is very simple because guys are very simple. That's all there is to it. Capture all, a few, or even one of these qualities and your chances of landing a great guy will definitely increase.

Chapter 6: Environment and How Guys Act

Have you ever seen a guy one place and he's acting a certain way, and then when you see him somewhere else he's acting completely different? This is due to a change in the social environment, that's all there is to it. Here's why guys act the way they do in these specific settings.

General Public

Guys still feel a need to be cool in these settings, again because they're social, but for the most part they're there to get drunk and hook up. If they have a story to tell their friends the next morning then all the better. Guys will act friendly, be overly touchy-feely, and may invade your personal space sometimes depending on how much they've had to drink.

They're honestly there to have a good time just like you. The only difference between you dancing drunk and him being a drunk is that he seems like a douche bag and you seem like you're having the time of your life. You can't expect guys to act like gentlemen or complete sweethearts in an alcoholic setting, especially when you show up wearing next to nothing. As the saying goes, "boys will be boys."

The Bar or Club

Even though bars and clubs are also social settings, guys have a little more self-control because they're in a public place of business. I know what you're thinking, guys still act like jerks, douche bags, assholes, dicks, etc. Remember, I said a LITTLE more self-control, not a lot. Again, "boys will be boys." In these environments guys are more likely to be outgoing and have a fun time, because the entire atmosphere revolves around just that - fun.

Guys will go to bars to have drinks with groups of friends, to watch sporting events or to deliberately pick up on women. When it comes to clubs, guys aren't there to dance with their guy friends. And no guy genuinely likes being in a place where he can barely hear the person next to him talk because the music is so loud. They're there to spot a pretty lady and hook up that night, or arrange a

meet-up for a later date. So if a guy is acting really friendly, now you really know why - not that you didn't already know that. Guys will suddenly transform into whatever you're looking for in a guy just to fit the perfect profile for the moment. It's what guys do at clubs and it isn't going to change, it's been happening for decades and will continue to happen for many more to come.

Chapter 7: Think Like A Man

When you're reactive to what men do, you'll never get anywhere because you're always a step behind. Instead of reacting, what if you knew what men were going to do before they did it? What if you could be on the same page or even a step ahead? It's time to start thinking like a man, it's time to take the proactive approach.

The Predator vs Prey Thought Process

If you're like any other girl, your thought process is probably that of the prey. Meaning you sit back and wait to get approached by men, in hopes of landing the right guy. Sure you might flirt from time to time, but unless you're always around a ton of eligible bachelors, you aren't seeing much action.

Guys on the other hand are always in the predator mentality. When we see a girl that we're physically attracted to, we have to approach her or at least be in her presence. We immediately become aware of our surroundings. Where we are, where she is, is she alone or with friends, if she is with friends how many, is there a guy around that might be her boyfriend, what's her mood like, does she seem friendly or bitchy.

There are tons upon tons of things that are going through our minds when we spot "that girl." If you want to be that girl, you have to know how to position yourself, and that's exactly what you're going to learn how to do. It's time to start taking notes, you're going to need them.

Use What You've Got

If you're shy, use being shy to your advantage. If you're outgoing, use that to your advantage. If you like dressing up like a clown, use that to your advantage! Ok, maybe not the clown part, but you get the idea - **use what you've got to get what you want.**

What you may think is a disadvantage is actually an advantage. As I said earlier, guys like all types of girls. Although we like the Victoria Secret model look, it isn't necessarily the look that every guy is looking for.

Guys like to see that you strut what you're working with in a physical state and even in a mental state. If you're outgoing then be funny and involve us in that fun. If you're shy then ask questions but remain mysterious, it'll spark our interest. You have qualities, you just need to use them in a big way that best fits your personality. This will no doubt turn what you think are weaknesses, into your main strengths.

Step Out of Your Comfort Zone

I know I just said that you should use what you have to your advantage, but it definitely does not hurt to gain a little experience. You want to be proactive and make things happen if you want to land a guy. Chapter 8: Approaching

When guys approach girls, their heart is beating really fast because they don't know what the outcome is going to be. But instead of chickening out, they get a surge of confidence and say "screw it." This is the mentality you need to go in with when approaching men. You need to be confident in your ability even when you're not.

The Only Approach You Need to Know

Trust me when I say this is really the only approach you ever need to know. You can use this approach anywhere and everywhere. When you approach a guy he isn't really going to expect it. It's not the social norm for girls to approach guys, so by doing this, you're already separating yourself from the rest of the girls in a good way. You always want to walk and smile with confidence, if you don't believe in your ability then why should he?

You always want to walk up to the guy with the goal of making small talk. Get to know him in under 2-3 minutes and get a feel for his personality. Just by talking and getting to know the guy, asking him questions, it takes a ton of pressure off him and he'll love it. From his perspective, the conversation will seem effortless, this is what you want him to think and feel.

After you've sized him up for a couple of minutes, your next move is to get his number. I know what you're thinking, "why would I want to get his number?"

The reason you want to get his number is because you don't want him blowing your phone up.

Any guy that has a woman approach him and then gets her number will automatically assume that she wants to hit the sheets. Maybe so, but you really don't want that kind of attention. Also, by getting his number it puts you in a position of power. You can decide later if he deserves your time or if you can find someone else better. You aren't pimping, you're just making friendly conversation and "browsing" the market before you "buy" so to speak.

If you're wondering how to get his number, just ask! Remember, guys are simple. Use something like "hey so I have to go back to my girlfriends" or "I have to get to my next class", followed by, "so here give me your number and I'll text you later." Give him a friendly smile and then walk away, it's that simple. Now you have the power to text him and set something up, or leave it as it was and meet a new guy without him ever bugging you.

The Don'ts of Approaching

If you're ever drunk off your ass you should never approach - EVER. Guys don't want to talk to sloppy drunks, they'll just end up making fun of you with their friends. This is not the attention you want to attract. And since it's random for girls to approach guys in the first place, your sloppy-ness will make you stand out in an even worse manner, so don't do it.

Now although guys love the idea of a girl coming up and initiating the conversation, they don't want to carry the whole conversation. That's like when

you text a guy "hey" and he says "hey what's up, what are you up to?" and then you text back "nm.." It's going to be a conversation killer and create an awkward moment, so don't go up and then not contribute to the conversation that you just started.

Always make an effort to contribute but don't talk up a storm, ask questions, reply and then ask more questions. Also, remember to never give out your number. You don't want to be doomed with an inbox of text messages, when guys are desperate they'll text away sober or drunk, it really doesn't matter. The word "standards" means nothing when a guy is horny.

Don't ever bring your friends with you. If you're going to talk to a guy then always isolate yourself, guys don't want to talk to you and your friend. It takes more effort trying to figure out which one of you is interested. This will always cause confusion and will usually end up with both of you leaving dissatisfied.

The only exception is if he has a friend with him, in which case you can have a wing woman. Other than that, leave her back with the rest of your friends and look to isolate the conversation.

The Lesson to Be Learned

You can't be afraid to get shut down when approaching. No one hits a home run their first time up at bat (although it can happen), so be patient and use your failures as experiences to learn from. Remember, if you quit, getting a guy will never happen. Well, it probably will, it just won't be the guy that you wanted in the first place.

Learn from your past failures and use them to your advantage next time you approach a guy. You'll build up more confidence and it will definitely show the next time around.

Chapter 9: Getting Approached

If you're wanting to get approached, make sure you're dressed to impress and are also positioning yourself in the right ways. This is important since guys decide within 10 seconds if they see you as a friend, a hook up, or as potential girlfriend material.

Different Settings and Placement

Men are hunters! So we only attack when you're in the right place. If you're at church for example, it's unlikely that guys will approach to engage in a forward like conversation. A guys state of mind will be in family mode, church mode, and spiritual mode. As hot or attractive as he may think you are, it won't be the right time or place for him to isolate and go in for the kill.

If you're out at in a general public setting like the dog park, coffee shop, grocery store, school or freaking McDonald's - your chances of getting approached greatly increase. These are good public settings where the fear of rejection for guys goes down. Guys are more likely to approach you in a general public setting because the chances of seeing you again are slim to none, the risk is virtually eliminated.

Being at a party, bar or club are other settings where guys are more likely to approach. The atmosphere is already there for social interaction, so the overall vibe of talking to strangers is normal. However, these are also settings where who you're with plays a big factor. Guys won't approach you depending on who your immediate social circle is.

Here are a few examples to better paint the picture:

[Example 1: You're at the School Library, Grocery Store or Work](#)

You're studying at the library, shopping at the grocery store or on the clock at work. You see a guy that catches your attention, better yet you see him looking back at you. What do you do next to hint to him that you want him to make a move?

The absolute best thing you can do is smile and look back when he looks at you. He's obviously interested in you if he keeps looking or you've got something in your teeth. In all seriousness you need to send a non-verbal invite.

If you're at the library, get up and throw a piece of paper away at the trash can that is closer to him than to you. If you're at the grocery store, go look at the same foods that he's looking at even if you have no interest in buying them.

As long as you're positioning yourself in his plain site and are alone, the chances of him asking you out are far greater than if you were to play cat and mouse. Guys don't like the chase when the prize is running away.

Regardless of where you work, it's easy to get approached since you're already in an atmosphere where communication is key to running a business.

Make a small gesture that you like his shirt or hat and then smile while making eye contact. He'll probably start coming in more often and will specifically see if you're working so that he can ask you out if he didn't do it the first time. Reality does set in sometimes and guys will think "ahh I should have asked her out."

A lot of the times it has nothing to do with your positioning, sometimes it comes down to guys not having enough confidence in themselves to make the first move. Don't let a few shy guys ruin your chances, keep making yourself available through non-verbal invites!

Example 2: You're at a House Party

You're at a house party with some of your friends from school, and you see a guy that you find attractive, what do you do?

If you're at a house party then it's really easy to get a guy to talk to you. Chances are you're at a mutual friends party or know some of the same people there. This is always good since friends will usually introduce each other to other friends.

The best way to get approached is to honestly just have fun doing your own thing. Position yourself as the girl who has fun regardless of what's going on. If some negative drama happens, don't give it your time, just carry on having a good time because that's what you're there for.

Guys are attracted to the fun girls rather than the anti-social or negative ones. You should really be engaged in everything that's going on that's attracting positive attention towards yourself. This is definitely the position you always want to take when at a house party.

Now if you want to enter a booty shaking contest, you'll definitely have guys talking to you afterwards, but it won't be for the right reasons. So engage in the house party with some drinking games, dancing, and by having fun with your girls. Do these things and you'll attract guys in a more positive light.

This isn't to say that all the guys that talk to you will be the right guy, because there are a lot of jerks, but that's why you get their number and then filter from there.

Example 3: At the Bar

You're at the bar with a group of your guy and girl friends, you want a guy to approach you but none seem to be coming your way. Now what?

Positioning yourself at the bar is a lot different from house parties. At a house party there's usually a lot of mutual friends or are drinking games which make it easy to break the ice.

At a bar, there are tons of groups and sometimes guys don't want to offend the wrong person - in short, guys become a lot more cautious of which girls they talk to.

So if you want to get approached at a bar, as discussed earlier in how to approach, you want to isolate yourself. For the most part it can be you and one other girl, but in order to get a higher approach rate, isolation is key.

If you're with a group of friends, go up to the bar and get a drink by yourself instead of bringing the whole crew with you. Then you can go back and rejoin them later on.

If a guy sees that you went to get a drink by yourself, it comes off to him that you don't have a boyfriend. Guys assume that if you did have one, he'd be the one getting up to get the drinks or would be right next to you.

The main key to getting approached at the bar is isolation. Guys want to talk to the girl who appears to be single, rather than the girl who's with a group of friends. It makes the approach a lot easier without the risks of him offending anyone - like the boyfriend you might "appear" to have.

Example 4: At the Club

Guys already know that girls love to dance and have fun. The thing is, a lot of guys don't know how to dance - very sad but true. You're hoping a guy comes and dances with you instead of grinding on you, but there doesn't seem to be any approachers.

A lot of guys are intimidated by large groups of women and prefer to work with a smaller group of friends or just you. There are always guys who want to dance, but they fear the embarrassment of being turned down, so they stay with their friends with their back against the wall.

If you see him looking, send him a smile and in some cases waive him down to dance with you! With tons of people dancing, loud music, and tons of eyes crossing paths, it's easy to get confused with who you're communicating with.

Guys would rather you invite them to the dance floor with eye contact and a physical gesture (hence the waive) and a smile rather than them going up with the fear of looking like a fool.

Also, what you wear plays a big part if the right types of guys are to approach you. If you're wearing next to nothing, you aren't going to find a guy that's actually interested in you, but you will find a guy that's interested in hitting it and quitting it.

So dress accordingly, you can still look sexy without showing cleavage or having your ass hang out. Remember, it's all about reflecting the type of guy you want, even at the club. So if you want the right guys to approach you, dress accordingly. Wear something that shows you've got style but that you aren't a whore while still showing you can be sexy.

Side note: Truthfully, your chances of finding a genuine guy at the club are slim to none. Not to say that there aren't any good guys there, but that's where you can usually find the bad boys and players who are only out for the booty. So if you're looking for a hookup or for a sancho, head to the club and you'll have plenty to choose from.

Chapter 10: Setting Up the Date

You decided that you wanted the guys number, so you approached him or made yourself available to be approached. Now that you have his contact information, how do you go about setting up the date? Do you call or text? You don't want to seem needy but at the same time you don't want to seem like you're blowing him off. Here are the best things you can do to make sure you set up a successful date.

The 2 Day Rule

Guys have this thing where when we get a girls number, we always wait two full days before actually getting in contact with her. This is the same approach you need to take with a guy who's number you just got.

Always wait 2 days before calling or texting. If you contact him anytime before that you'll seem needy and pushy. Relax, you have his number, you're in control. As soon as the third day comes up you're in the clear. From there you can decide if you're still interested in getting to know him.

Should You Call?

Calling shows that you're genuinely interested in this guy. It separates you from the rest of the girls in a good way, however, it can be kind of awkward at the same time. Generally speaking, guys are used to it when a girl texts instead of calls since these days it's more of a norm to text.
